The spacious and luminous interiors combined with light coloured woodwork, whiteness and stainless steel are the essence of conviviality and comfort.

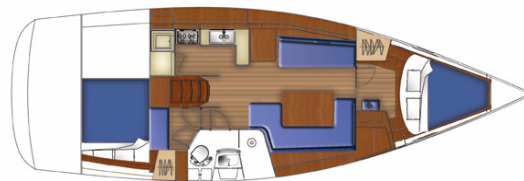
